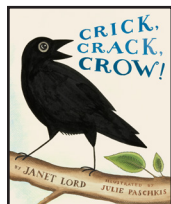
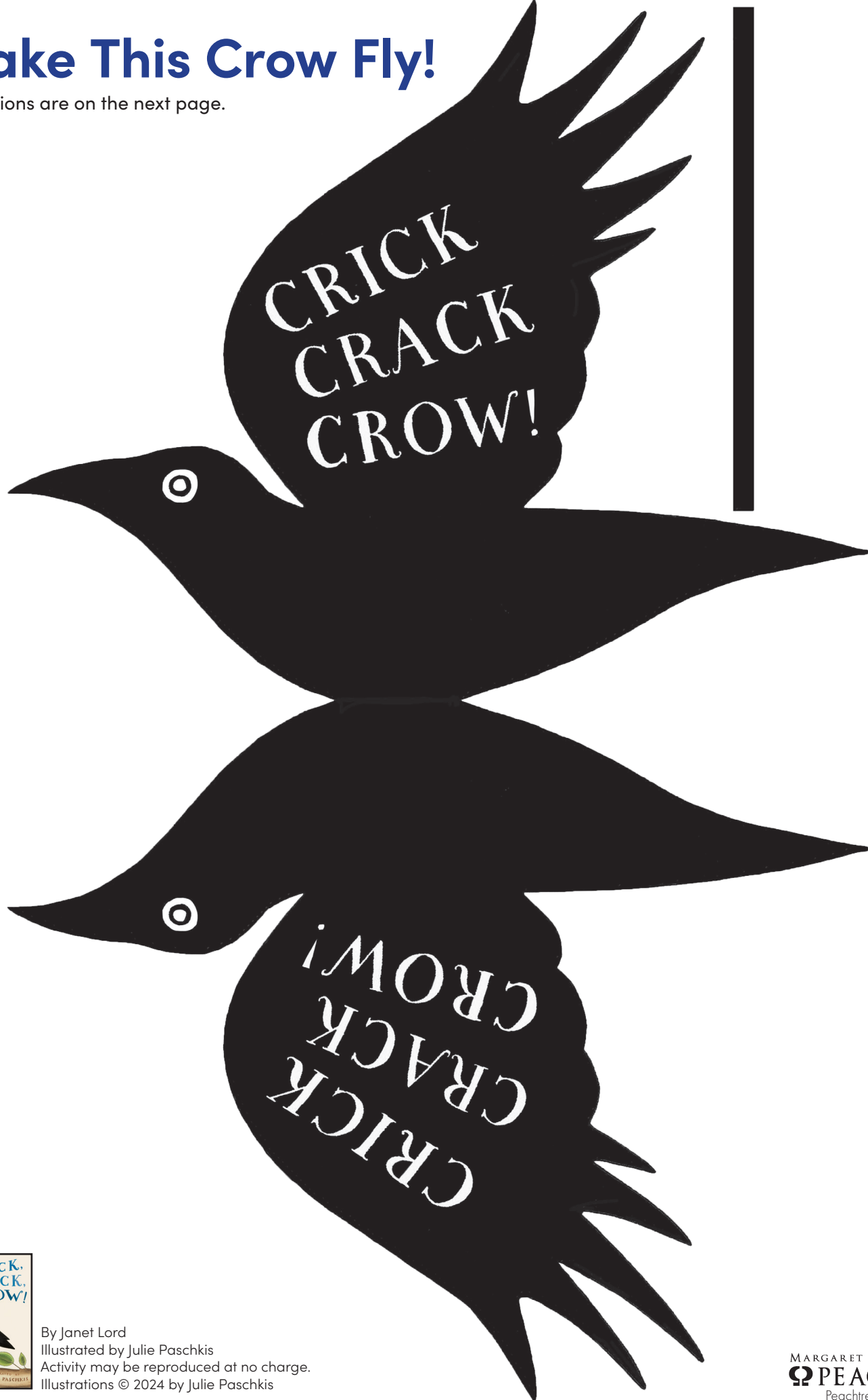


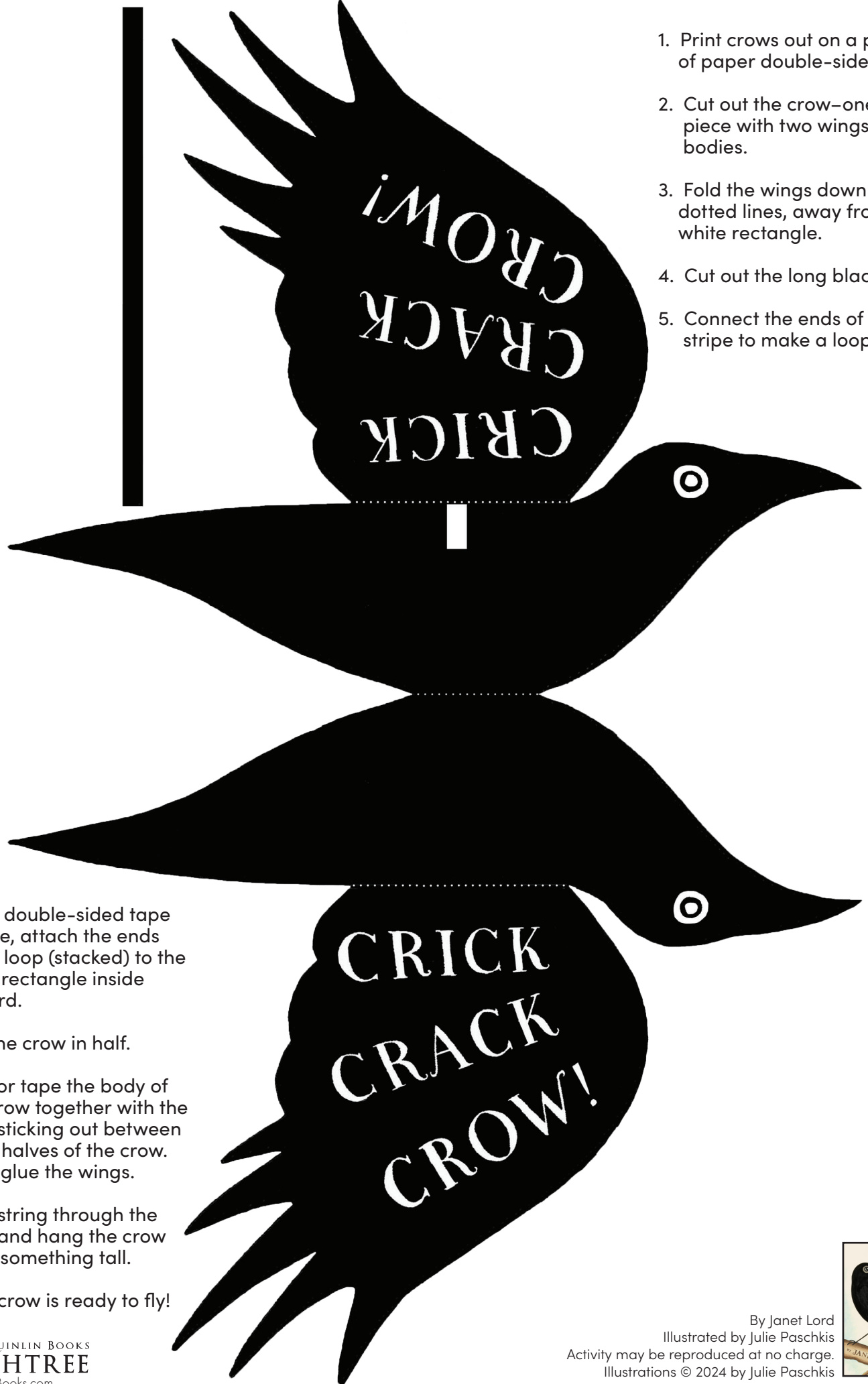
# Make This Crow Fly!

1. Print crows out on a piece of paper double-sided.
2. Cut out the crow—one big piece with two wings, two bodies.
3. Fold the wings down at the dotted lines, away from the white rectangle.
4. Cut out the long black stripe.
5. Connect the ends of the stripe to make a loop.

6. Using double-sided tape or glue, attach the ends of the loop (stacked) to the white rectangle inside the bird.
7. Fold the crow in half.
8. Glue or tape the body of the crow together with the loop sticking out between the 2 halves of the crow. Don't glue the wings.
9. Tie a string through the loop and hang the crow from something tall.
10. Your crow is ready to fly!
